The regular meeting of the Band Parent Association of Flowery Branch High School was called to order at 7:00pm by Al Sweet, BPA President.

I. Approval of Agenda

- Chocolate – Chocolate fundraiser starts today and will run for thirty days. For each box sold, the student earns \$30 towards student account.

Randy Beyke gave an update on concessions. Sign-ups for all games are available on the band website. We need approximately twenty people to run the stand effectively. Parents were reminded that the concession stand is one of the primary fundraisers for the band.

Parent volunteers are needed for the concession stand. Working a shift in the concession stand is a part of the volunteer requirements for band.

Band will be hosting the Branch Classic at FBHS on October 23, 2021. The competition will start around noon and end late in the evening.

We have been successful in getting volunteers but need additional help for the second shift. We encourage family members, friends or organizations in need of volunteer hours to sign up.

We are still in need of ATV and trailers to help bands move equipment throughout the day. We also need additional food donations for the Hospitality area.
